This wine list is dedicated to the memory of Leo Morris, whose passion, warmth, and love of wine continue to inspire us.

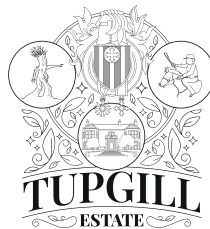

Champagne

It is the most prestigious sparkling wine in the world made only from grapes grown on the chalky soils in Champagne, the most northerly of France's wine regions.

1. Jacques Boncoeur Brut Reserve 65.00

Beautiful aromatic complexity of green apples and lemon zest with undertones of brioche and hazelnut. Delicate, persistent mousse on the palate fuses with a subtle combination of structure, vivacity and a creamy texture that envelops the core green and citrus fruit with added minerality.

2. Jacques Boncoeur Brut Reserve half bottle (37.5cl) 36.00

3. Jacques Boncoeur Brut Rose 70.00

Bursting with classic red berry fruit and citrus on the palate, and a delicate, full-bodied, lingering finish. Beautiful flavour with an engaging natural freshness.

4. Taittinger Brut Réserve 85.00

Taittinger crafts their signature Brut Réserve Champagne from a blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier grapes scrupulously selected from over 35 different vineyards and vintages. The blend has a high proportion of Chardonnay which gives the wine a delicious freshness and subtle complexity. Full-bodied and elegant, this is consistently excellent fizz.

5. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé 150.00

Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé was created in 1968 and has become a classic. It is known for its salmon pink colour and ripe red fruit aromas and incredible freshness. The palate is clean and with flavours of Morello cherry, strawberry and black cherry.

Sparkling

Sparkling wines can be made all over the world. The fizz is caused by carbon dioxide gas that is produced by fermentation and trapped in the wine. In the Prosecco region of Northern Italy and in our new English fizz, Silver Reign, this occurs in a big stainless-steel tank (Charmat method), which preserves the fresh fruity character of the grapes.

6. Prosecco DOC Brut Terre di Sant'Alberto Italy 36.00

Terre di Sant'Alberto's Tenet is an excellent Brut Prosecco that is fresh, elegant and balanced. A fusion of green apple with added white stone fruits flows through onto a long, lingering finish.

7. Prosecco Brut Terre di Sant'Alberto Rose Italy 36.00

Prosecco Rose is an exciting new category from the Prosecco region. Crafted from 85% Glera and 15% Pinot Noir to produce a delightfully fresh and fruity Prosecco that fills the glass with red summer berries and white flowers.

8. Prosecco DOC Rose Villa sandi - 20cl 9.50

9. Silver Reign Charmat Brut, Silverhand Estate, Kent England 48.00

Delicate aromas of elderflower, white hedgerow flowers, pear and apricot, lead to a fine mousse and refreshing finish, with lingering flavours of citrus and ripe stone fruit.

10. Silver Reign Charmat Brut Rose, Silverhand Estate, Kent England 48.00

Charming aromas of strawberry, raspberry and cranberry lead to a fine mousse and refreshing finish, with lingering flavours of summer berry fruit on the crisp, refined finish.

Alcohol Free

11. Zonin Sparkling Cuvee Zero Alcohol Free - 20cl Italy 9.00

Crisp, refreshing alcohol-free sparkling wine with bright citrus, green apple, delicate bubbles, lively finish, perfect for any occasion.

12. Torres Natureo Muscat 0% ABV Spain 25.00

Aromatic, alcohol-free Muscat with floral, orange blossom, and ripe peach notes, light-bodied, refreshing, and subtly sweet finish.

White

Light, crisp, refreshing white

Crisp dry whites are always a favourite. They are light, refreshing, and approachable. These wines are very versatile, due to their zesty acidity, and a great match for seafood and lighter dishes. They can also be enjoyed on their own, without food. Perfect at any time of the year, but they are especially appreciable during the warm months.

13. Pinot Grigio, Defina, Veneto Italy 28.00

This crisp Pinot Grigio has a delicate pale straw colour. It offers lovely citrus fruit flavours on the nose accompanied by soft honey undertones. The taste is crisp and refreshing, with a lingering finish of zesty green apple.

14. Picpoul de Pinet Cuvee Prestige France 34.00

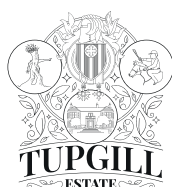
Produced in the Picpoul de Pinet appellation of the Languedoc-Roussillon region, where the Mediterranean breezes cool the vineyards and allow Foncalieu to create this refreshing, citrus-laced white wine. Beautifully fresh and brimming with crisp green fruit and lime. Perfect with any seafood dish.

15. Sauvignon Blanc, Taringi, Marlborough New Zealand 36.00

Classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Lovely lifted notes of gooseberry and ripe guava on the nose and a beautifully fresh, crisp palate with vivid fruit lengthened with a generous dry finish.

16. Gilbert Chon Muscadet Sevre et Maine Sur Lie 'Clos de la Chapelle', Loire France 38.00

A fresh and energetic Muscadet by Gilbert Chon, made with the Melon du Bourgogne grape variety, from his 4-hectare vineyard of 'Clos de la Chapelle' that bursts with green fruits as well as crisp, vibrant acidity and a beautiful saline finish. A perfect match for shell fish.



Ripe, juicy, fruit-driven white

These delicious whites tend to come from warmer climates where there has been more sunshine to ripen the grapes. The fruit character is slightly more intense with more tropical and exotic flavours. These are great on their own but will stand up to dishes with more flavour intensity

17. Chenin Blanc, Post Tree Coastal Region **South Africa** ✓ 26.00

Crowd-pleasing Chenin Blanc bursting with guava, gooseberry and citrus, balanced by crisp acidity, fresh finish.

18. Chardonnay, The Listening Station, Victoria **Australia** ✓ 32.00

An exciting new Chardonnay from Victoria in Australia where the bright, sunny days and cool nights create this unoaked and refreshing Chardonnay with an abundance of citrus fruit. Bright and fresh on the palate with racy acidity leading into a linear and mineral finish.

19. Viognier, Domaine de Montmarin **France** 34.00

Classic aromas of peach and apricot with hints of grapefruit. Ripe and round with a lovely creamy aftertaste that flows through into a white pepper-dashed finish. Pure and precise.

20. Rioja Blanco, 'unoaked', Cune Monopole **Spain** ✓ 36.00

100% Viura showing white flowers, tropical fruit, ripe citrus, mango, elegant texture, refreshing acidity, long finish. A versatile wine to be enjoyed as an aperitif or to match a broad range of foods.



Elegant, refined and complex white

This selection are from the best-loved European white wine regions, from the grapes that have thrived in their specific areas for centuries. These wines are named after the region, rather than the grape variety, and reflect the environment or 'Terroir', where they have been grown. They are famous for their enduring quality.

21. Gavi D.O.C.G. , Roberto Sarotto Tenuta Manenti Bric Sassi Italy 39.00

The Sarotto family has grown grapes in Gavi since the 16th century. At Tenuta Manenti's Bric Sassi vineyard in Zerbetta, 50-year-old Cortese vines on Miocene marl and tuff soils yield a crisp, mineral-driven wine. Citrus, white peach, pineapple and guava notes combine with ripe freshness and linear structure.

22. Macon-Lugny Les Genievres, Louis Latour, Burgundy France 45.00

Crafted from grapes taken from the Les Genievres vineyard in Lugny which is known for producing some of the best wines in the Maconnais.

Attractive nose lemon citrus, grapefruit, and honeysuckle. Ample, rounded, and ripe on the palate with an abundance of further citrus and white stone fruit complemented by the almond and honey undertones on the fresh, lively finish.

23. Albariño, Rectoral do Umia, Bodegas Gallegas, Rías Baixas Spain ✓ 47.00

From cool, maritime Rías Baixas, this Albariño offers pure fruit and vibrant freshness. Aromas of lemon, grapefruit, honeydew and white flowers lead to a crisp palate bursting with citrus and subtle tropical notes. Zippy acidity drives precision and tension, finishing long, saline and mouth-wateringly clean.

24. Chablis Seguinot-Bordet, Burgundy France 55.00

Chablis from Kimmeridgian soils showing citrus, green fruit, melon, flinty minerality, saline finish, structured, poised, and elegantly expressive.



Rosé

Whether you're after a delicate, dry wine from Provence with flavours of red berry fruit or a sweet one from California that tastes of strawberry laces, we have a lovely selection of Rosé wines to tickle your taste buds.

25. White Zinfandel Rose, Portraits of America LA USA 26.00

Easy-going rose from California, simple and straightforward. Off-dry and laden with flavours of strawberries and cream, clean acidity and a good touch of sweetness adding balance.

26. Pinot Grigio Blush, La Delfina Italy 28.00

Delicate salmon pink in colour with an enchanting nose full of soft summer fruit flavours. Light bodied and very easy-drinking.

27. M de Minuty Rose Cotes de Provence France 45.00

M de Minuty is located near St. Tropez on the Cote d'Azur and is a classic Provence rose with its pale pink colour and aromas of red berries and a touch of stone fruit. The palate is laced with strawberry and raspberry and balanced by fresh, crisp acidity with a long, mineral-driven finish.



Red

WINES BY THE BOTTLE

Bright, fresh, juicy red

Some wines were just not designed to be big blockbusters. This section of wines are elegant and fresh, low in tannins and rely on a delicate structure and perfume rather than power. They pack a fruity rather than fleshy punch. Perfect for pairing with lighter, white meat or even fish dishes and can be served lightly chilled.

28. Tempranillo, Chispas, Campo de Borja Spain 26.00

Tempranillo from Campo de Borja with red cherry, plum, black pepper spice, plush juicy palate, ripe tannins, concentrated, structured, satisfying finish.

29. Pinot Noir Ombremont, Bourg Lachamps Ardeche France ✓ 30.00

Vibrant nose of red cherry and strawberry with hints of wild herbs. Soft, silky tannins and generous summer berry fruit core with hints of black pepper spice on the balanced finish.

30. Sangiovese Favugne, Teanum, Puglia Italy 32.00

Sangiovese from sunny Puglia, showing red cherry, plum, chocolate, liquorice, soft silky tannins, black pepper spice, medium-bodied, generous finish.

31. Merlot 'The Old Museum', Franschhoek Cellar, Western Cape South Africa ✓ 34.00

Named for the museum in Franschhoek which chronicles the history of the early Huguenot settlers, who introduced the first wines to South Africa's Western Cape in the 17th century. 12 months ageing in oak casks before bottling adds complexity and a dusting of vanilla to the soft red cherry and plum flavours.

32. Fleurie Maison de la Madriere, Stephane Aviron, Beaujolais France 46.00

Located in the heart of the region, Fleurie is often regarded as the 'Queen of Beaujolais'. Forward, vibrant nose with black raspberries and cherries. Really juicy with loads of energy and vibrancy. Summer berry fruits, multi-layered core with floral and violet undertones and long finish.



Rich, bold, warming red

These red wines are the quintessential food wine because they have balanced tannin and moderate acidity. Great with or without food and pair particularly well with casseroles and pies, game, red meats, poultry, mushrooms, roasted vegetables, cheese and spiced dishes.

33. Shiraz, The Listening Station, Victoria Australia ✓ 32.00

Attractive aromas and flavours of black cherry and black plum with classic eucalyptus overtones. Medium to full-bodied with soft, silky tannins and ample texture leading into further black fruit core with a generous dash of black pepper spice on the long, lingering finish.

34. Quinta Vista Reserva, Casa Santos Lima, Lisboa Portugal ✓ 33.00

A blend of Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz, Castelao and Syrah with captivating aromas of red and black cherry, black plum with added dark chocolate and touch of spice..

35. Primitivo IGT, Cielo Primasole, Puglia Italy ✓ 36.00

Intense ruby red in the glass with a delicate bouquet ripe red and black fruits with a hint of violet. Smooth on the palate with an abundance of juicy plum, blackberry and blueberry fruits. A lovely long finish with some spice and cocoa notes.

36. Malbec, Kaiken Clasico, Mendoza Argentina ✓ 38.00

Highly regarded Chilean producer Aurelio Montes crafts this wine, named after kaikenes, a breed of wild Patagonian geese that fly across the Andes. Originally from France, Malbec is the definitive red wine grape of Argentina, producing red-blooded, spicy wines with flavours of intense black fruit, chocolate and violets.



Classic, full flavoured, complex red

With a history that stretches back beyond Roman times the Europeans have learnt a thing or two about wine making! Here are a selection of red wines from classic wine regions that we believe you can taste some of that history and romance in each bottle. Full of flavour, these wines have complex layers of flavour and a richer mouthfeel. Perfect for pairing with intensely flavoured dishes from lamb shanks to beef Wellington, these classic wines have the wow-factor and will enhance and complement full flavoured dishes.

37. Cotes du Rhone Rouge Reserve, Famille Perrin France 40.00

One of the prominent producers in the region (producers of Chateau de Beaucastel). Impressive nose of black cherry, blackcurrant and liquorice spice. Generous and ample on the palate with ripe, round tannins and balanced purity and fruit depth. Great match for Lamb dishes or any game.

38. Chateau Cissac, Cru Bourgeois, Bordeaux France 48.00

Chateau Cissac has been owned by the Vialard family since 1895. The vineyards are situated on a plateau to the west of Pauillac and St. Estephe, with 60-hectares on sandy-gravel and clay-limestone soils that produce a classic and reliable Claret. Fresh and full-bodied at the start, with a black fruit bouquet. The tannins are silky smooth on the finish, giving plenty of depth and balance.

39. Barolo 'Castagni' DOCG, Michele Reverdito Italy 65.00

Outstanding, fully developed and drinking Barolo from the wonderful Cru classified vineyard of Castagni. Charming notes of dried strawberry, cherry, violet, leather and mushroom characters. Silky palate with more farmyard characteristics; mushroom, prune and ripe cherry that are beautifully married with good fruit purity and freshness. Impressive tannin structure and black pepper spice on a lingering, mature finish.

40. Nuits-Saint-Georges, Ambroise, Burgundy France 85.00

The estate is working towards full biodynamic status and currently they use a number of natural and sustainable processes to produce their wines. Dominant black fruits on the nose with a slightly smoky character. Excellent weight of multi-layered black fruits core with a velvety texture that flows onto a generous finish.

41. Château Langoa Barton, St Julien, Bordeaux France 120.00

Château Langoa Barton has remained in the hands of the Anglo-Irish Barton family since 1821, making it one of the rare Bordeaux estates owned by the same family for over 200 years. Its wines showcase classic Saint-Julien elegance, combining blackcurrant, cedar, graphite, and earthy nuances with smooth tannins, balanced acidity, layered dark fruit flavours, and a long, refined finish that reflects the family's enduring dedication to quality.

Rich blackberry and plum flavors with cocoa, warming spice, and a long, velvety finish, lingering. Pair with dark chocolate, blue cheese, or nut-based desserts.

44. Fino Sherry, Tio Pepe, Jerez, Spain 50ml 4.50 40.00

Bone-dry and crisp, showcasing almond, green apple, saline notes, and a sharp, refreshing finish classic. Perfect with olives, salted almonds, seafood, or cured meats.

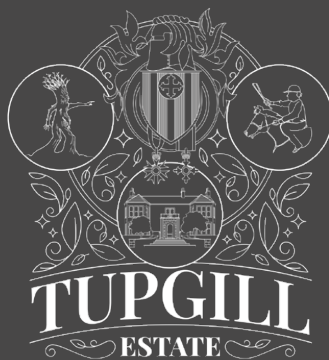
